



Shot Contest Tournament Director Instructions:

- 1) Display all 8 shots near 3-cushion tables so that players can practice them.
- 2) Display flyers of event in as many places as possible.
- 3) At the event, fill out the “List of Players” – get their email addresses.
- 4) Collect \$ 5.00 entry fees – these go to the room owner/tournament director.
- 5) Use stick-ons (paper reinforcements-the little sticky circles) for each shot.
- 6) All players shoot the first diagrammed shot 3 times. Each time they make it, they get 2 points. After each attempt, the player shoots a straight-rail carom shot wherever the balls lie (no rails are necessary). Each successful carom shot is 1 point. So each player will actually shoot 6 shots per turn. After all players have made their attempts for shot # 1, then remove the stick-ons and place new ones for shot # 2. The maximum possible score is 72 points.
- 7) With 16 players, the event should take between 3-4 hours altogether.
- 8) If there is a tie for 1st, 2nd or 3rd place, the tie-breaker will be the opening lag.
- 9) Once the competition is over, it is CRUCIAL that you give every player a copy of the “Follow-Up Material” so that they can continue their interest in the game.
- 10) Prize Payouts: \$ 200 for 1st Place , \$ 100 for 2nd and \$ 55 for 3rd.
- 11) List of things that need to be sent to the person in charge of sponsorship money:
 - a) Completed list of players with email addresses
 - b) Completed Score Sheet
 - c) Picture (digital preferred) of top 3 finishers in one photo (indicate who is who)
 - d) Brief story of the event

Information and/or picture can also be emailed to the person in charge of sponsorship money.

- 12) When all is received in good order, you will receive a check for \$ 255.00.
